# Linn S. Chapel Celebrates 100 Years in Business! CHAPEL L

t 100 years old, Linn S. Chapel Lumber (LSC) stands proud as a cornerstone business in the Elmira Community. In its fourth generation of family ownership, LSC is the only lumber and building material dealer left in Elmira, outlasting almost a dozen supply companies in the immediate region.

It all began in 1913 when two friends and business associates decided that they would venture into the coal business. Harry H. Hayes, an insurance agent together with Linn S. Chapel, who actually worked for Hayes at the time (at his insurance agency), went into business selling coal. Shortly afterward, Hayes ventured away from the company to pursue a law career while Hayes' son-in-law James R. Beecher was brought in.

In 1925, Linn S. Chapel, as owner of the company, incorporated as Linn S. Chapel and decided with Beecher to go into lumber and built the first sheds at the yard.

For the next couple of decades, Chapel and Beecher built up the coal and lumber business. In 1929 alone, Linn S. Chapel sold 322 carloads of coal—13,000 tons—while expanding their lumber business.

In 1943, Chapel passed away and James R. Beecher was elected president, with his son John H. Beecher at age 12 beginning to ride shotgun on lumber deliveries. In 1966,

John H. Beecher was elected president after his father passed away. That year, Beecher tore down all the coal silos to focus the company entirely on lumber and building materials, and in 1968 built the store that stands at its current location.

Over the next several decades, LSC grew under the hard work and direction of Beecher, who was a very dynamic person according to everyone who met him. In his time stores were tried in Mansfield, Pa., and Ithaca, N.Y. Beecher also made the critical decision
